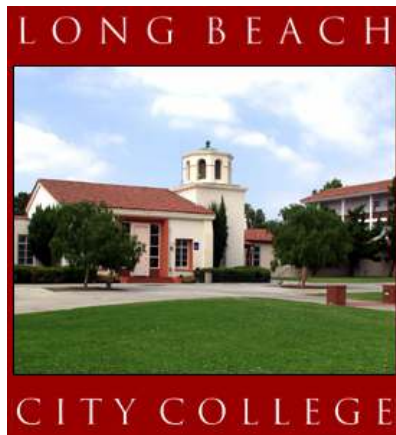

"We operate on a rolling admissions system, which means that students are evaluated every day, once all their admissions documents have been received," says Ross Miyashiro, Director of admissions and records. "Laserfiche really keeps the process moving, enabling us to issue as many as 200 admissions confirmations in a single day."

Once admitted, students continue to receive VIP treatment thanks to Laserfiche, according to Peter Maharaj, student services technical manager. Counselors may access student files in Laserfiche, to review academic progress and advise on future course work. Maharaj has additional plans for his system. He is currently completing a migration to the SQL platform, which will be step one.

"After that, I wish to integrate Laserfiche with PeopleSoft technology so that our admissions and counseling records in Laserfiche will integrate with academic coursework records in PeopleSoft," Maharaj said. "Being able to share archived information from both systems will greatly enhance our ability to serve the LBCC student body."
